There were 15 members and 2 partners present to welcome Alastair who with his partner Jane Mann will add strength to the Club.

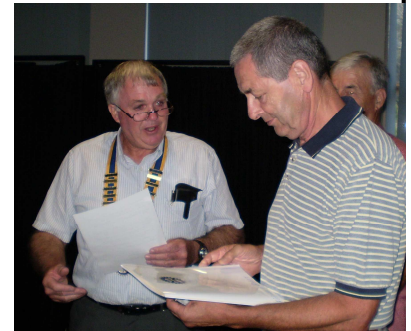

THE AUCTION

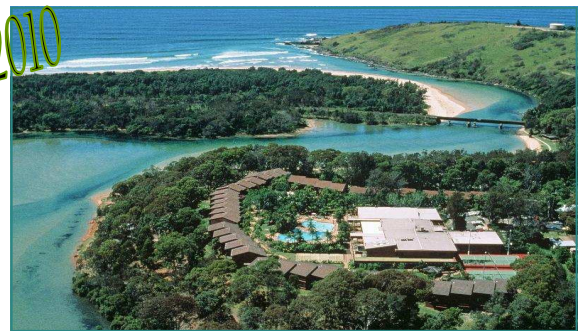
