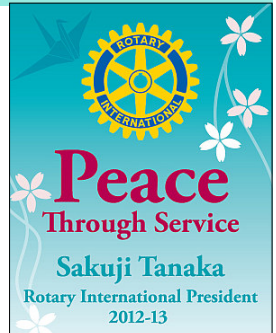

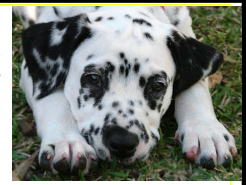

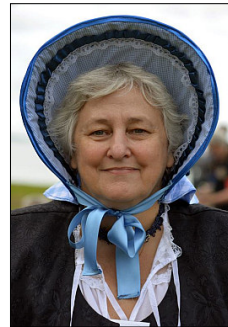


## CLUB NEWS
