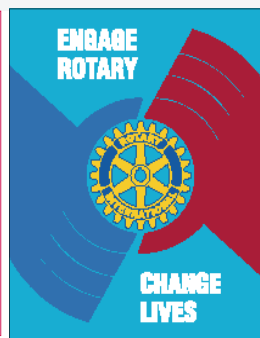

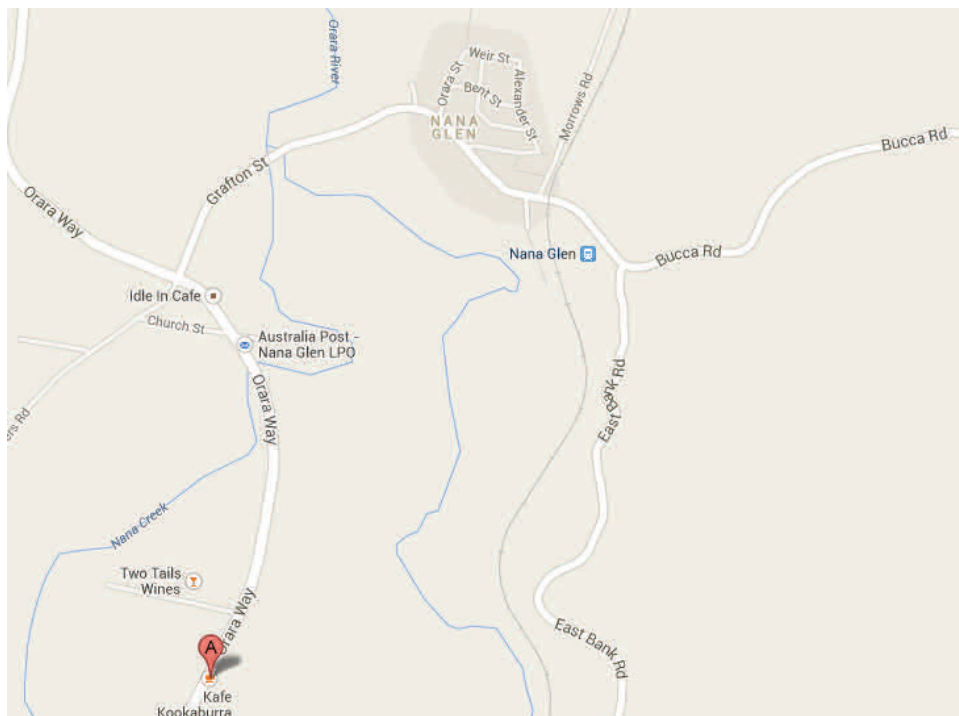

PREVIOUS MEETING 9 DEC—HONEYWELL ESS / AGM

The highlight of our previous meeting was the three presentations by our students who attended the **Honeywell Engineering Summer School** in Sydney on 1-6 Dec: **Dylan Verhoef, Callon Roach** and **Joshua Partridge**. HESS had a deep impact on all three, though in strikingly different ways. All three were profoundly grateful for the experience, and thanked the club and Woolgoolga High School for their sponsorship: “awesome experience”; “amazing; perfectly what I was looking for”; “best experience of my life by far; great people”. (The club had also sent Dylan’s brother Simon to HESS two years ago.)

Dylan’s experiences have set him on a path towards a career in electrical engineering; HESS changed Joshua’s preference away from civil & environmental engineering to mining engineering; while Callon’s career shift was the most dramatic: he has decided that engineering is not for him, and is now planning a career in commerce and law! Apart from a rich variety of engineering-related experiences, all three gained an insight what life would be like at university.

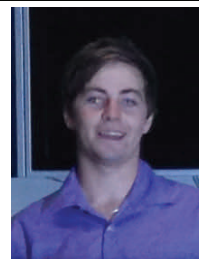
