12 AUGUST—We are travelling to Nova Scotia

We don't have a guest speaker so the Fayles are going to show us some slides and talk about their recent Nova Scotia trip...about as far away from Australia as you can get.



Nova Scotia (means New Scotland) is one of Canada's 3 maritime provinces on the Atlantic side of the American continent. Nowhere in Nova Scotia is more than 67km from the ocean - a land of bays, estuaries and beautiful unspoiled scenery.

It was home to the Mi'kmaq Indians and settled by French colonists in the early 1600s (they called it Acadia). They were then kicked out by the British in the early 1700s. The first significant migration of Scottish settlers was in 1773 and coinciding with the Scottish highland clearances more and more Scots migrated to Nova Scotia in the late 1700s and early 1800s.

If you love little villages full of art and craft, if you love Gaelic music and square dancing concerts, and if you love lighthouses, majestic natural scenery and warm friendly people then put Nova Scotia on your bucket list.
