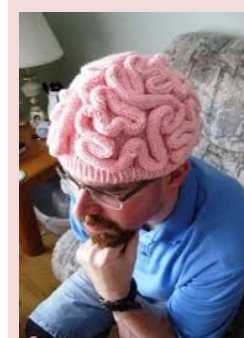
*From the President's Desk*
