Bring extra cash for our **Melbourne Cup sweep on the night**.

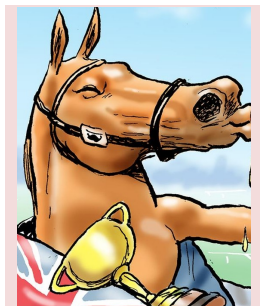

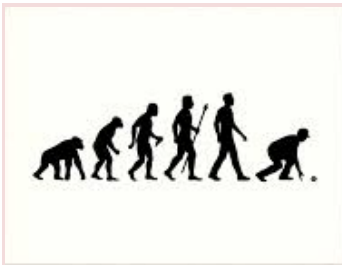
From the President's Desk
