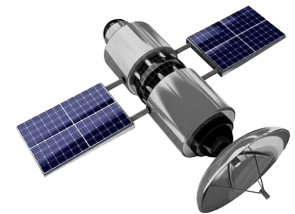


Rotary has turned 100
