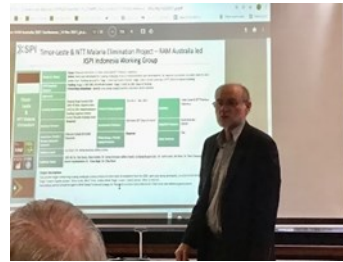

Rotary Xmas stall at Mullaway Primary School 4 December:

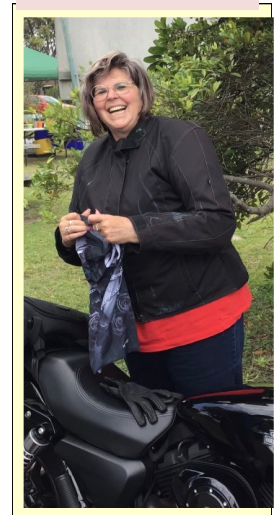
