Unfortunately our guest speaker had to cancel. Consequently members continued to present two-minuters on 'the most interesting person I have worked with.'

Public Officer & TRF & Patty spoke about a Cancer conference she attended years ago in Atlanta, where she met an inspiring Cancer surgeon Gordy Klatt. This doctor started a team fundraising event in 1985 'Relay for Life'. It was a 24 hour walk for people (inc cancer survivors and carers) to run/walk ending in a candlelight ceremony. This raised \$27,000 at the time. The walk has since spread all over the world and includes about 4 million people in 26 countries who have raised \$80 million. Sadly, Dr Klatt developed stomach cancer himself and died in 2014, but his money raising legacy still lives on.

Kim spoke about a Salvation Army chaplain at the site of the Kempsey bus crash. Kim had no idea of his name but "he was so sweet and caring with the most incredible blue eyes. He spent time quietly checking on all the first responders: doctors, ambulance, police, nurses, firefighters, SES. He provided a touch on the shoulder with a gentle squeeze when you really needed it most. I never heard him speak but I can picture him so clearly. I wonder if anyone checked on him to make sure he was ok"


