roster of Rotarians to assist. Please do what you can to **spread the word to as many local men as possible**.

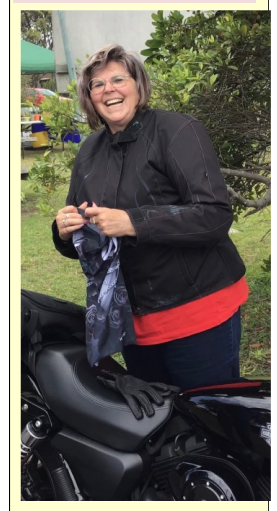


Sawtell Rotary Trivia Night
