#### **LAST MEETING Monday 10th October**

Paul Hughes, a visitor from the Rotary Club of Kuri Kuri, provided a positive feel about the future of our club.

Paul's club went through a lean period: between 2010 and 2016 membership dropped as low as 8 and they had no guest speakers for some time. Through a variety of means they have rebuilt membership to its current level of 17. They conducted a New Members Night to which each member was to invite two



guests as potential new members. Finger food was provided to encourage standing, moving and mixing. Of the 15 guests, 5 subsequently became members. First year of membership is free. Members may then choose to pay membership fees by direct debiting \$5 per week. New members are asked which project they would like to support.

They started a breakfast club at the primary school (gaining 4 new members) and an Interact club at the high school. The club runs a Christmas Grocery Grab which raises around \$8000 and a bbg which raises around \$600 per month. Paul emphasized two points: camaraderie and hang in there! Thanks Paul.
