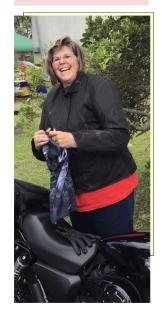

Power To The Kids, Our club donated \$300 to help this Pitch a Project begin with an Introduction Presentation at 5.30pm on Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup> at the new Wilgulga Sport and Multi-purpose Centre. Power to the Kids is the brainchild



of Dr Annemarie Winters, and was created to eliminate or at least reduce the amount of mental health issues besetting our children. Annemarie has become aware of unresolved mental health issues becoming increasingly more evident in her role as an emergency department doctor. She is witnessing presentations of self-harm at

emergency departments in our younger generation. There were around 30 to 40 parents and interested community members present to hear the Introduction Presentation by Dr Nicola Holmes. Nicola has had extensive experience in raising mental health awareness having worked for "Headspace" a national youth mental health organisation for 10 years, specifically

educating General Practitioners and more recently delivering her own awareness and educational presentations to the parents of high school and primary school aged children. The overarching objective of the program, is to make our kids more resilient, less anxious and thereby "empowered". We want our children to realise that it's OK not to be in control of their

feelings and there is a safe place to discuss their feelings. The monthly program will work on educating and providing strategies for the parents of all our children to cope with the afore- mentioned challenges (research shows that a supportive family unit is the key ingredient to better mental health outcomes).

Patty has been busy co-ordinating with the University of Newcastle, Wilgulga Centre management plus other companies that our club will need to hire to help make the day run successfully.
